



## Public Comment Period Extended for the Fallon Range Training Complex Modernization Draft Environmental Impact Statement

The U.S. Navy has extended the public comment period by an additional 30 days for the Fallon Range Training Complex Modernization Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). Public comments may now be submitted until **Feb. 14, 2019**, for consideration in the Final EIS.

The U.S. Navy prepared a Draft EIS to assess the potential environmental impacts of modernizing the Fallon Ranges. Modernization would include: 1) renewal of the Navy's current public land withdrawal, 2) land range expansion through the additional withdrawal of public lands and the acquisition of non-federal land, 3) airspace expansion and modifications, and 4) upgrades to range infrastructure.

The proposed modernization would provide more realistic training capabilities while maintaining the safety of local communities.
